**Euless W5EUL 442.900**

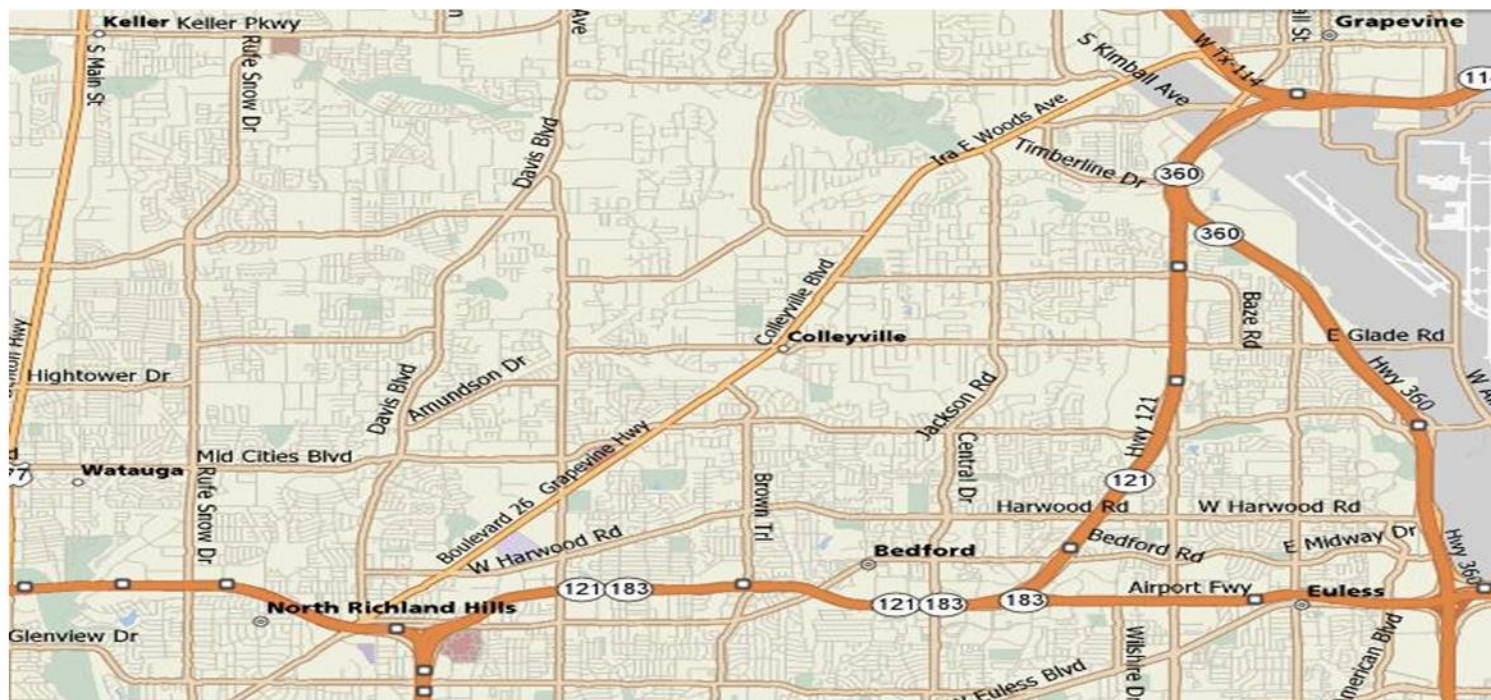
**HURST W5HRC 147.100**
